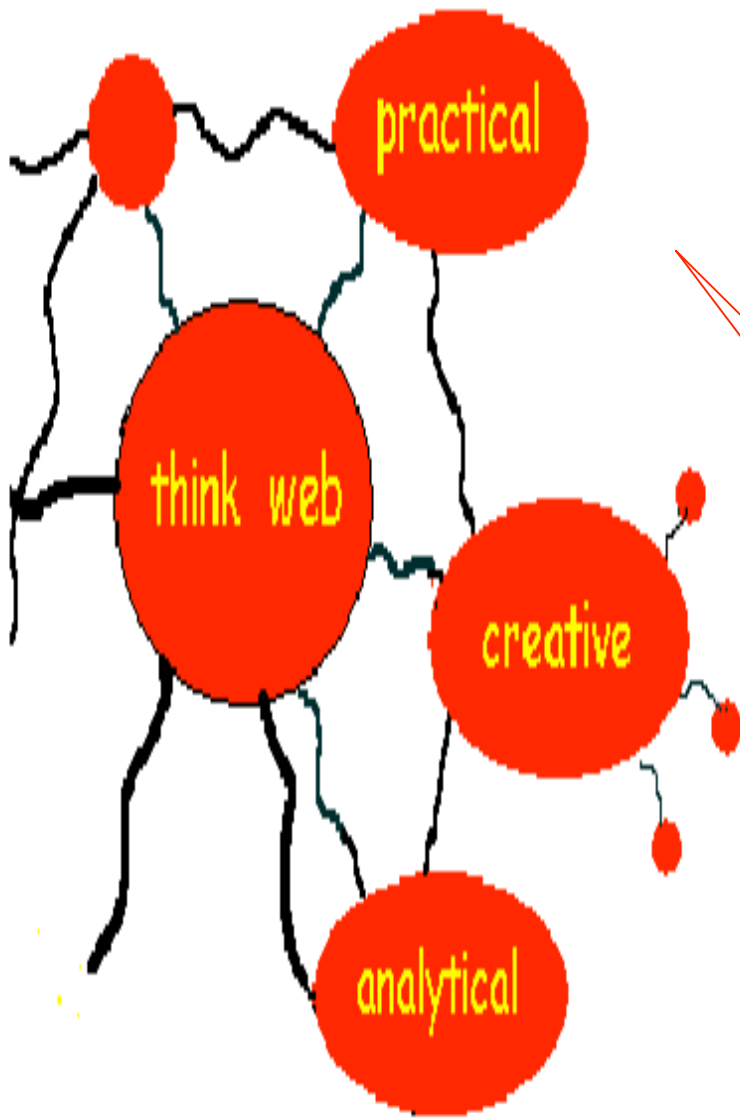

- Do you have anything you wish to say from your own point of view or experience?

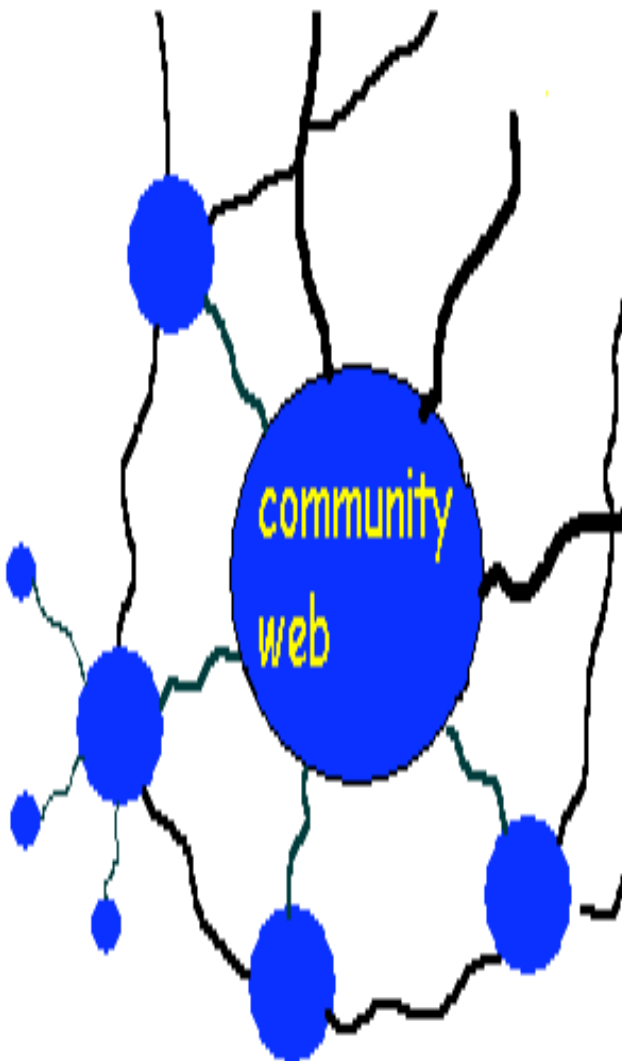
About the main character:

- What's the worst that could happen to him or her?

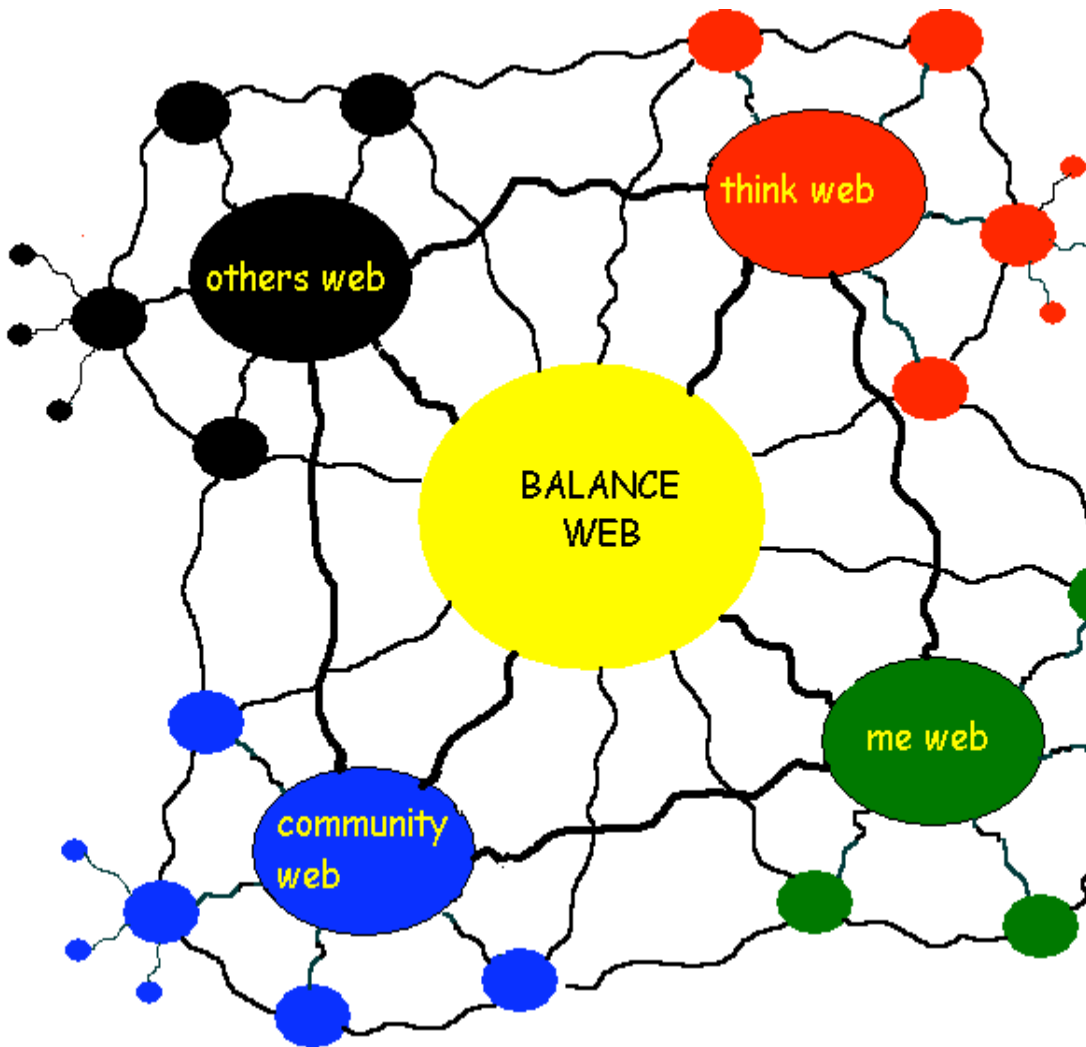


- o Who is mentioned in the dilemma?
- o Is there anyone else who might be affected?

- o What would happen to the character?
- o How would he or she feel?
- o How would he or she feel if they found out what had happened?
- o What would he or she like to happen?
- o What does he or she know about the dilemma and the suggested solution?



- What communities are involved? (School, family, village etc.)
- What would happen if everyone chose to do this?
- What would people think about the community?
- How would it look to other people?
- What would happen in the long term to the family or class?
- What might other people in the community learn from what had happened?



**Think by yourself and then together:**

- o Which solution do you feel is the right choice?
- o Why do you think this?
- o What were the good things about this choice?
- o What were the bad things?
- o What about the other solutions - why have you rejected them?

- o Did you listen well and learn from each other?
- o Did you build on each other's ideas or did you defend your own even though it might not have been the 'wisest' solution?
- o Are you pleased with your contributions?



- o How do you feel now the enquiry is over?
- o Do you think you worked together to find the best/wisest solution?
- o Are you happy with the final choice?
- o Did you change your ideas?
- o Did you ask questions?
