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A professional practitioner

- A professional practitioner engages in a programme of continual professional development, which includes researching their practice to:
 - improve it,
 - evaluate it,
 - generate and test the validity of their accounts for their educational influences in learning (their livingeducational-theories)
 - contribute the knowledge they create to the growth of global knowledge with a new Collective Imaginary.

Distinguishing education research from educational research

- Education research is research carried out within the conceptual frameworks and methods of validation of disciplines of education such as the philosophy, psychology, sociology and history of education.
- Educational research generates valid, evidence and values-laden explanations of educational influences in learning with values of human flourishing.
