'What might be done to encourage people to enter into educationally productive dialogue with groups and individuals across the globe that contributes to the flourishing of humanity?'

We have been developing responses to this question by encouraging virtual connections through SKYPE and virtual presence in the form of living-posters.

A living-poster is an attractive A4 poster which show the values that motivate the researcher and give their life meaning and purpose and which form their explanatory principles and standards of judgment. Indicates their context, research interests and passions, details of a few key publications, the url to their 2-3 min Youtube video (and website if they have one) and contact details.

We began asking and researching living-posters and virtual participation through SKYPE as a response to this question in the Town Hall Meeting at ARNA conference 2015 in Canada organised by Jacqueline Delong and subsequently at the workshop organised by Sonia Hutchison in South Africa at the ALARA conference, 2016 and most lately for a workshop and paper presented at the ARNA conference 2017 in Colombia.

Since 2015 idea growing:


- New group and individual posters received
