How EDS started

Due to Dr. Hafizur Rahman's experience of severe bullying and punishment in school in Bangladesh, which forced him to pause his education, he created a supportive learning environment for out of school children in 1988. He wanted to ensure the children felt safe and valued, free from the struggles Hafizur endured. He believed that relationships based on trust and empathy foster the best learning. In 2005, Hafizur, Md Alamin and Trine Lund established EDS.

Who runs EDS?

EDS is run by vulnerable children and youth in Bangladesh who were previously out of school due to a mix or reasons like joining youth gangs, child labour, orphans, planned child marriage, negative sosial control, bullying, domestic violence, poverty



and lack of basic needs. Now they are leaders, teachers, change agents and social entrepreneurs who use their transformative experience to mentor other vulnerable children and youth for the same.

Our aim and activities

EDS aims to empower young people to become change agents through love. The EDS change agents volunteer 3-8 h/day, 6 days/week to

- •Teach and give 300 vulnerable children/youth grade 1-12 free education
- •use own experiences to mentor vulnerable children/ youth for critical thinking, taking healthy decisions for their lives
- •Cultivate an integrated fish, shrimp, rice, vegetables and fruit tree farm (6000 m2) and a roof garden (2000m2). They use these as interdisciplinary learning arenas.
- Teach ICT
- Conducts home visits and parent meetings to get out of school children back to school and join EDS
- •Advocate for children's rights towards local authorities and educational institutions
