Paula is very dark skinned and has black hair but is a very bonny baby. She was placed with Mrs. [REDACTED] by Miss Cooper, Child Care Officer from Salisbury, on 6.7.66. Her birth weight was 5 lb. 4oz. and on 6.7.66 she weighed 10 lb. 12 oz. She eats and sleeps well and is described as a very placid child. She has her last bottle at 7 p.m. and sleeps through the night until 7 a.m. Both the [REDACTED] think a lot of her.

When placed, Paula had plenty of clothes and Miss Cooper provided a new carry cot and two dozen nappies. She also gave Mrs. [REDACTED] the milk token card and a pink card to obtain a medical card.

Mrs. [REDACTED] is a very experienced foster mother but does not attend the clinic. She said that as with the other children, she will take Paula to be weighed at Boots every week and in any case of doubt, she will consult Dr. Smith, the G.P.

What's changed since summer 2019? I have a new role, which is like roles I have undertaken before. I am a school improvement advisor working with heads and leaders in primary schools to improve the outcomes in their schools. I work across 30 primary schools in the borough of Bracknell Forest with 6 colleagues.
