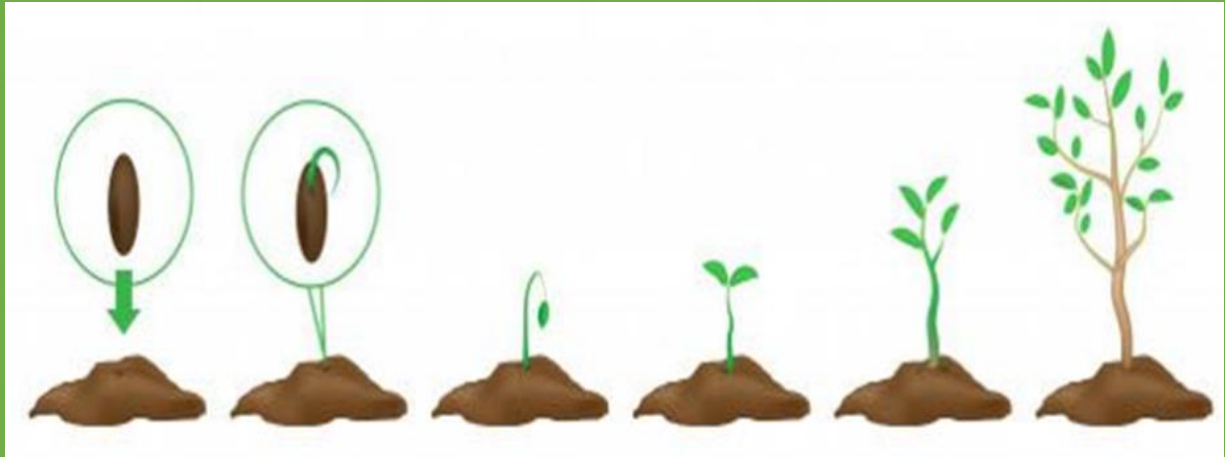


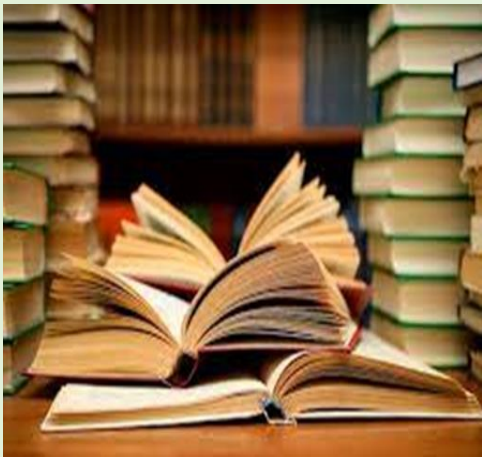
DUT ACADEMIC INDUCTION 2022 PROGRAMME.
